

- I **was** happy yesterday.
- You were at school on Monday.
- He **was** a taxi driver two years ago.
- She **was** my best friend last year.
- It **was** nice to be with you.
- We **were** lucky.
- You were tired at the weekend.
- They were in Prague in summer.



plural

Questions - singular

- John was lucky.
- ² 1 3
 Was John lucky?

- + Yes, he was.+ Yes, he was lucky.
- No, he wasn't.No, he wasn't lucky.

Questions - plural

Children were hungry.

² 1 3
Were children hungry?

+ Yes, they were.+ Yes, they were hungry.

- No, they weren't.

- No, they weren't hungry.

Questions – other examples

- John was at home at the weekend.
 - **Who** was at home? John.
 - □ Where was John at the weekend? At home.
 - □ When was John at home? At the weekend.
- My parents weren't in Prague because they were busy.
 - **Who** wasn't in Prague? My parents.
 - □ Where weren't your parents? In Prague.
 - **Why** weren't your parents in Prague? They were busy.

Translate

- To nebyl dobrý nápad.
- Tamty knížky byly pro nás příliš drahé.
- Byli jste s nimi v pondělí odpoledne?
- Proč nebyl tvůj bratr včera v kině?
- Kde byla Jana před třemi týdny?
- Kdy jsi byla naposledy šťastná?

Translate Solution

- It wasn't a good idea.
- Those books were too expensive for us.
- Were you with them on Monday afternoon?
- Why wasn't your brother at the cinema yesterday?
- Were was Jane three weeks ago?
- When were you happy last time?
